



## Teamcenter Administration Task

### Disable Preferences Shared Memory for SFB-Teamcenter-8568

#### Synopsis

Siemens PLM Software recommends disabling preferences in shared memory until Tc 11.2 (~July, 2015).  
 See SFB-Teamcenter-8568 for details.

#### High-Level Process

- 1) Shutdown the environment (services\processes)
  - a) On remote servers.
  - b) On Web/App servers.
- 2) Run in a Tc command window
  - a) clearlocks -assert\_all\_dead
  - b) install -lock\_db
- 3) Delete the shared memory directory
  - a) TC\_SHARED\_MEMORY\_DIR
- 4) In custom env file (or directly in tc\_profilevars.bat)
  - a) set TC\_USE\_PREFS\_SHARED\_MEMORY=FALSE
- 5) Run in a Tc command window
  - a) generate\_metadata\_cache -u=infodba -p=infodba -g=dba -force
- 6) Optionally clean up
  - a) Clear logs in TC\_TMP\_DIR
  - b) Clear logs in TC\_LOG (%TC\_DATA%\log\_%TC\_DB\_SERVER%\_%ORACLE\_SID%)
- 7) Run in a Tc command window
  - a) install -unlock\_db
- 8) Restart the environment (services\processes)
  - a) On App/Web servers.
  - b) On remote servers.

#### Default Values

TC\_NO\_TEXTSRV\_SHARED\_MEMORY = FALSE  
 TC\_USE\_LOV\_SHARED\_MEMORY = TRUE  
 TC\_USE\_METADATA\_SHARED\_MEMORY = TRUE  
 TC\_USE\_PREFS\_SHARED\_MEMORY = TRUE

#### Notes

The side effect of turning off shared memory is that each tcserver takes additional memory as below:

Shared Memory Segment	Additional Memory (per tcserver)
Preferences	~2-4MB
Metadata	~19MB
LOV	~5MB
TextServer	~6MB
